1. CALL TO ORDER AND PRAYER: Pam Hibler, Chairman, called the meeting to order at 6:01 p.m. with a prayer offered by Jace Henderson.

2. CONSENT AGENDA:

 Ken Daughtry made a motion to accept the items on the Consent Agenda. Maria Ford seconded the motion; the vote was unanimous.
- 3. EMS REPORT: Skye Lane's report stated that all three trucks are running and stocked. They continue to train in-house and online. Tandy Drake, an eleven-year employee, will be leaving after December 28th, 2024. An ad has been placed to advertise the position. Two people have responded. They responded to twenty-eight calls in November.
- 4. CNO REPORT: Mandy Meadows reported that nurse staffing is currently adequate. The administrative RN nurse is still filling in when a shift needs to be covered. A night shift RN resigned to move to a full-time day shift at another facility but requested to remain on the PRN list with Parkview. Two nurse aides have been hired, with one being dismissed at the 90-day probation period. The other moved to a full-time position with the hospital and will work PRN with assisted living. Mandy continues to attend the Rural Healthcare Coalition for CNO's every first Wednesday monthly. It has enabled her to receive valuable information about services and resources that are available for people in need.
- **5. FINANCIAL STATEMENT AND STATISTICS:** Jace and the board reviewed the balance sheet and the operating/income statement with the board. Questions were asked by the board.
 - a. Palo Duro G&P Suit Update Hemphill County won their lawsuit. Now we are awaiting the ruling on an Oklahoma case.
 - b. TruBridge/Vestra: Service from TruBridge has been dismal. Jace said they have a new representative, and that she was shocked. Vestra does billing for the Pampa hospital, and Jace is in discussions with them.

- c. **Health Insurance:** Healthsure will be using 90 Degree (third party administrator) for Parkview's hospital insurance benefits. They are doing an excellent job and are good at what they do. Canadian and Childress use them.
- d. **Price Transparency:** TruBridge wanted \$41,000 to do it; therefore, CFO Jace Henderson is going to do it.

a. Assisted Living Signage: Cecil is still searching for a source to make the signage for Assisted Living and the Emergency Room waiting room.
