Tanner Cadra is a PRN Basic and is currently taking the advanced class. Kelsi Cook will soon complete Paramedic school. Camryn Ryder has been hired as a PRN paramedic. The EMS team participates in community activities, and they responded to 32 calls during March.

5. CNO REPORT:

- a. Nurse Staffing: Mandy Meadows' report stated that the hospital is fully staffed. The Workplace Violence Prevention Program and Policy has gone before the policy and procedure committee and department managers. Planning for the mock workplace violence training scenario will begin after the review by the Parkview Hospital Board reviews the policy and program definition. Ken Daughtry made a motion to approve the Workplace Violence Prevention Policy Program and Plan. Marla Ford seconded the motion; the vote was unanimous.
