

NOTICE OF MEETING TO VOTE ON TAX RATE

A tax rate of \$0.497304 per \$100 valuation has been proposed by the governing body of Parkview Hospital (North 1).

PROPOSED TAX RATE	\$0.497304 per \$100
NO-NEW-REVENUE TAX RATE	\$0.498026 per \$100
VOTER-APPROVAL TAX RATE	\$0.532093 per \$100

The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2024 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for Parkview Hospital (North 1) from the same properties in both the 2023 tax year and the 2024 tax year.

The voter-approval rate is the highest tax rate that Parkview Hospital (North 1) may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate.

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that Parkview Hospital (North 1) is not proposing to increase property taxes for the 2024 tax year.

A PUBLIC MEETING TO VOTE ON THE PROPOSED TAX RATE WILL BE HELD ON August 19, 2024 AT 18:00 AT Parkview Hospital Board Room.

The proposed tax rate is also not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, Parkview Hospital (North 1) is not required to hold an election to seek voter approval of the rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting the members of the of Parkview Hospital (North 1) at their offices or by attending the public meeting mentioned above.

YOUR TAXES OWED UNDER ANY OF THE RATES MENTIONED ABOVE CAN BE CALCULATED
AS FOLLOWS:

$$\text{Property tax amount} = (\text{tax rate}) \times (\text{taxable value of your property}) / 100$$
